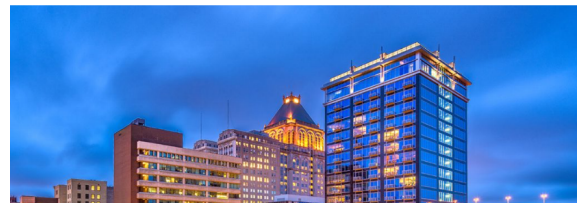

Alpha Nu Donates to Bail Fund

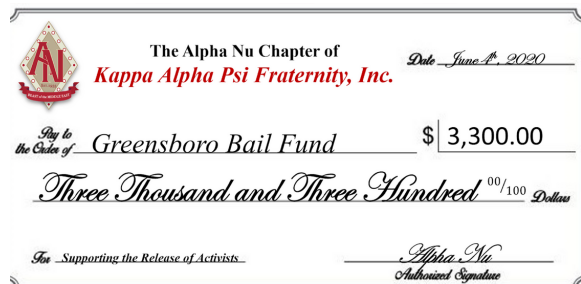

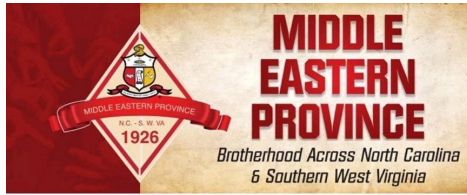

Alpha Nu's Probation Status Changed

With help from the Office of Student Development and the Office of Fraternity & Sorority Engagement, Alpha Nu's probationary status has been changed from disciplinary probation to social probation. With this new status comes a lot of privileges but a lot of responsibility also. Some of the changes involved with this new status are:

- Brothers will now be allowed to wear paraphernalia on Mondays as well as the already allowed Fridays
- Wristbands and lapel pins will now also allowed on "Pretty Boy Wednesday"
- Brothers can now visit the plots on Fridays from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. with the ability to stay as late as 12:30 a.m. with an advisor present. OSA must be notified 48 hours in advance if staying later than.
- 3 undergraduate members will now be allowed to be included in the intake process.
- The chapter will be eligible to host a maximum of 2 fundraiser a year with OSA approval.
