This inspired the birth of the Statesmen College Preparatory Academy for Boys in Washington, D.C. Highlight of Service

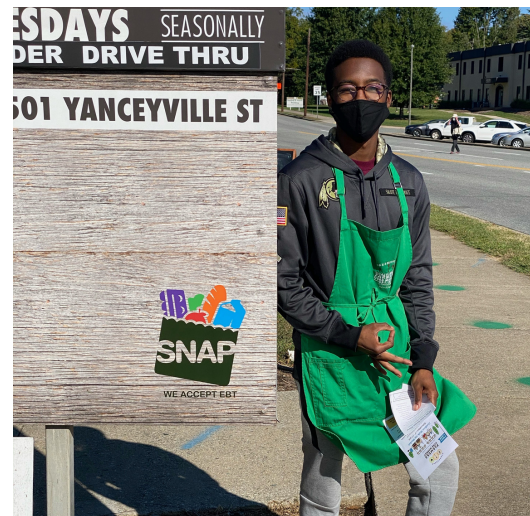
